
WORLD WAR II

ACTOIDS

• On Pearl Harbor Day 2005, some 3.7 million WWII vets are projected to be living. As of April 2004, 50 of 464 Congressional Medal of Honor recipients were still living. As of the end of 2003, 33,050 of the 130,201 POWs were still living.


• In all wars of the Twentieth Century, 35 to 40 million soldiers perished of which some 63% were the result of WWII.



WORLD WAR II ACTOIDS

• Estimated WWII casualties by country (military and civilian):

 GIs, whether in combat or non-combat roles, risked their life from both hostile and non-hostile causes. 28% of GI deaths, whether serving on the home front or overseas, were non-hostile.
72% hostile deaths caused by land, sea, and air battles (troopship sinkings, airplane crashes, etc.) 28% non-hostile deaths (disease, training accidents, etc.)
